In all cases where a Table Machine is to be used and wood is being cut, planned or thickened by machine a Push Stick or similar safety device must be used.

Ear and eye protection and dust protection devices are available and should be worn.

Any Tools or Machinery must not be operated unless there are two members present in the Shed.

## Other useful Information:

Our Annual Membership Fee is \$110.00 including GST plus a voluntary \$2.00 per week attendance donation.

You are also asked to make a contribution for any Shed wood that you use.

Our Shed year commences on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July and pro-rata fees are applicable for new Members joining within the Shed year.

Shirts in various styles can be ordered. The Shed subsidises the purchase of the first shirt.

The Shed operates Monday to Friday between 9 am and 12 noon.

To assist in maintaining the sustainability of the Shed there is a policy in place of '*build one for yourself and one for the Shed*' to sell. It is not necessary to build the same thing for the Shed, however, we ask you to build something of similar value or assist with a Shed project giving a similar commitment to the Shed as you have to your own project.

It is incumbent on ALL members to clean up after oneself and put away the tools you have used in their correct location. Please do not leave it to other members to clean up after you.

An Accident '*Near Miss Report*' or a '*Injury Report*' form must be completed as soon as possible after any incident.
